Measure E was passed by Irvine voters in June 2016 to ensure all Irvine Unified School District students; not just those in newer neighborhoods, have access to modern learning environments and technology to support IUSD's high academic standards and to prepare students for 21st century college and career opportunities. Measure E will provide a maximum available bond issuance of \$319 million for facilities improvements at 28 of the District's aging schools.

In Series 1 of the Measure E Improvements, the District has identified Northwood High School for a New Synthetic Track and Field. The work is scheduled to begin March 2018 and continue through July 2018.

All interested persons are invited to attend a Community Information Meeting, which will provide information on the work proposed for Northwood High School. IUSD representatives will be on hand to answer questions. This meeting will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 29, 2017.
